In addition to our NICU, our Heart Institute offers state-of-the-art recovery and monitoring for cardiac and heart surgery patients, achieving success rates that generously exceed national averages.

Our highly specialized, multidisciplinary team of experts continues to grow its breadth of experience. With new and expanding capabilities, we care for evermore complex and acute conditions with outcomes that remain above the standard.

Program highlights

- Because we see more than 400+ infants annually who require surgery while in our NICU, our providers have diverse expertise caring for complex conditions.
- With the most advanced medicines and technologies available, we're equipped with anything a baby might need, no matter how complex their condition.
- We offer a family-centered care model, which puts families at the center of every decision.
- Our NNP program offers comprehensive care at more than 10 sites across Colorado, and we have more than 100 neonatal nurse practitioners, educated at a master's or doctoral level, who are board certified by the National Certification Corporation.
- Our center meets the highest possible standards for utilizing extracorporeal membrane oxygenation (ECMO) to care for newborns with various life-threatening heart and lung conditions.

Communication

When a baby is in the NICU, parents may not be able to spend as much time there as they'd like. Through a program called Baby Chat, we use iPads to connect a baby with their family, allowing the family to talk and watch as their baby is cared for.

At discharge, our dedicated neonatal and surgical nurse coordinators work with families to make sure they are prepared, and we help schedule any necessary follow-up appointments that a baby may require.

We also partner with primary care providers to ensure a seamless transition of care. Our teledischarge program offers providers a privacy-protected, direct line of communication to us through Vidyo, a secure video chat software. This helps us continue to support ongoing care, especially for a baby with a medically complex condition, even if home is hundreds of miles away.

Access

Our Children's One medical transport fleet, which includes a helicopter and a plane, is specifically designed to serve neonatal and pediatric patients from all over the region.

- It is the only fleet of advanced air and ground vehicles in our seven-state region that provides critical care transport solely for neonatal and pediatric patients.
- We are accredited by the International Commission for the Accreditation of Medical Transport Systems.
- Our helicopter is designed to meet the needs of the tiniest patients. Featuring an improved platform for essential equipment and additional space for an isolette, it's quieter than most helicopters, making it the comfiest ride for our tiny patients.
- We have the capability to transport the sickest babies from wherever they are, allowing them to get the advanced care they need.
- Through our partnership with AirMed International, we have the ability to transport pediatric patients to or from almost anywhere in the world.

Research and innovation

We offer the most innovative technologies in neonatal medicine including:

- One of the first hospitals in the country to develop a centralized state-of-the-art lab for preparing breast milk.
- ECMO heart-lung bypass
- Hemodialysis and peritoneal dialysis for renal failure for server metabolic diseases
- Body cooling

Our doctors have pioneered many critical developments in neonatal care, and in many cases were the first in the world to use new therapies including:

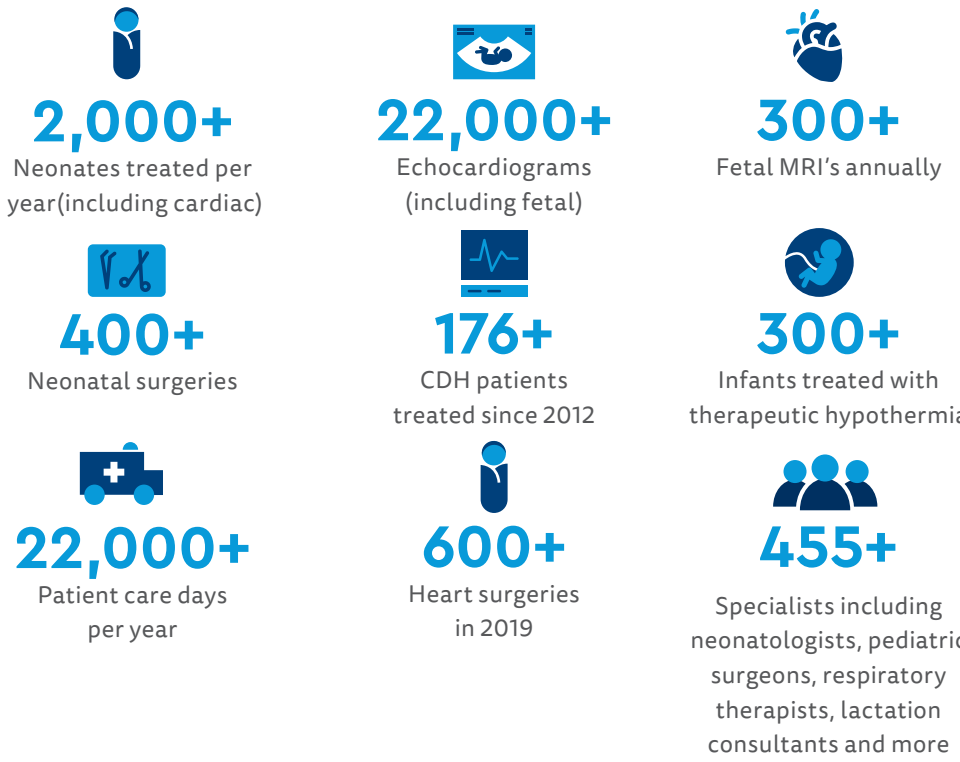
- Surfactant replacement for premature babies' lungs
- Inhaled nitric oxide therapy for pulmonary hypertension
- Brain cooling for perinatal brain injury
- Inhaled nitric oxide to prevent premature lung disease
- Optimal nutritional strategies for babies with low birthweight

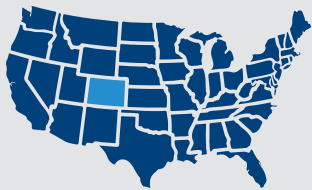
